Total donations this year increased 55% over 2017 (a 58% increase by weight). Network gave us a big thank you for much needed donations.

CRIME WATCH PATROL

Did you know Greenwood Hills has over 1,500 homes located on 45 streets? Currently, we have 15 residents who participate in our neighborhood Crime Watch Patrol. Having a consistent visible presence of an active group of citizens sends a message to would-be criminals in the area that their presence will be reported immediately. This risk of apprehension can be an effective deterrent to crime.

We need more volunteers! You can participate by volunteering as little as an hour a month to drive our neighborhood, reporting anything suspicious that you may see. To participate you simply fill out the online application, pass a background check, and attend a training class.
